	Foundational	Developing	Proficient	Score
Preparing for the Writing Task	Writer demonstrates no knowledge of prewriting strategies. Does not mark the prompt and does not create a writing plan. (0-2 pts.)	Demonstrates little knowledge of prewriting strategies. May mark the prompt but does not use a writing plan effectively. (3-4 pts.)	Demonstrates strong knowledge of prewriting strategies. Effectively marks the prompt and uses a writing plan. (5 pts.)	
Brainstorming	Does not create a brainstorm for the writing task or does not develop the brainstorm with details. (0-2 pts.)	Creates a brainstorm for the writing task but may give limited details. The brainstorm may not be useful. (3-4 pts.)	Creates a useful brainstorm full of ideas and details to help with the writing task. (5 pts.)	
Drafting	The draft is not useful; most of the text is missing or incomplete. (0-2 pts.)	The draft is somewhat useful; aspects of the prompt are missing or incomplete. (3-4 pts.)	The draft is very useful; all aspects of the prompt are present and developed. (5 pts.)	
Revising and Publishing	Very little time and effort went into improving the writing; content and grammar remain unchanged. (0-2 pts.)	Some time went into improving the writing; more focus should have been placed on content and grammar. (3-4 pts.)	A considerable amount of time and effort went into improving the writing; both content and grammar was revised. (5 pts.)
